NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2009~2012*.
- 1.2 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1 and 5 Category C, shall apply with an exception to boats where applicable class rules apply.

Sports boats shall carry an adequate sized motor and enough fuel to propel themselves to safety in bad weather

Life jackets must be worn at all times while racing.

2 ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats;
Centreboards, multihulls and Skiffs
Trailer Yachts and Keelers
- 3.2 Entries will be accepted Vauxhall Yacht Club on Friday evening (6.00 ~ 7.30 pm) Friday 2 March 2012, and Saturday 3 March 2012 8.00 ~ 9.00 am at Vauxhall Yacht Club and the University Yacht Club (beside the public launching ramp Otago Yacht Club).
- 3.3 To be eligible to compete in this event, each entrant shall be a financial member of a club recognised by the competitor's national authority.

For the Class events, each competitor, entrants shall be a financial member of the Class Association.

10 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be as follows:

Novice Centreboards:~ Triangle

Centreboard:~ Trapezoid

Keeler and Trailer Yachts:~ Triangle

11 PENALTY SYSTEM

11.1 RRS 41.1 is changed so that the Two Turns Penalty is replaced by the One Turn Penalty .

11.2 Decisions of the Protest Committee will be final as provided in rule 70.5.

12 SCORING

12.1 The scoring system is as follows:

12.2 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

(a) When fewer than five races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When from six or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

13 SUPPORT BOATS

No support boat may enter the race area whilst racing is in progress, except to render aid to a vessel in distress.

14 LAUNCHING

Ramps: There is two single ramps at Vauxhall for centerboards, and two double public ramps at Otago Yacht Club. There is a single ramp in the Otago Yacht Club.

15 HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

Keelboats shall not be hauled out during the regatta except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the race committee.

16 RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

17 PRIZES

Prizes and trophies will be awarded after the event.

18 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

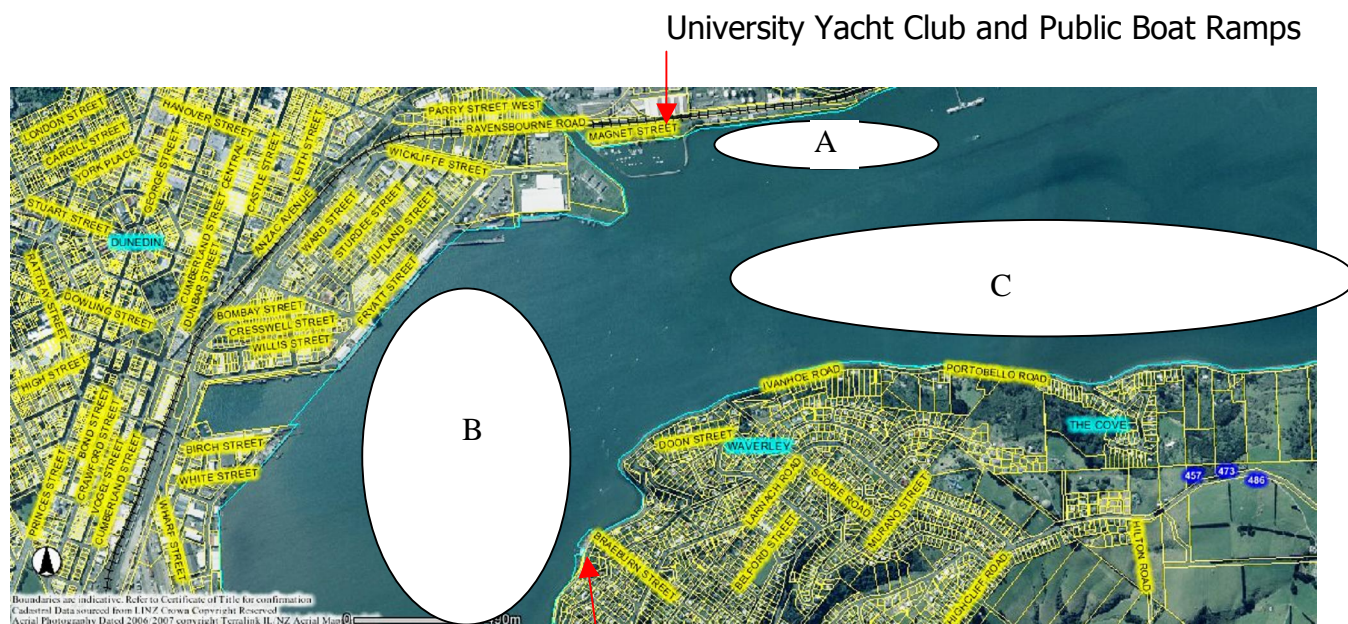
Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk.
