

NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- The Regatta will be governed by the Rules as defined in the “The Racing Rules of Sailing”
- YNZ Safety Regulations Part V Category C will apply
- For Protests, where only a Rule of Part 2 and Rule 3.1 is alleged to have been broken an Arbitration Hearing will be offered prior to any Formal Hearing.

2. ELEGIBILITY & ENTRY

- The Regatta will be open to all Registered Noelex 25 Yachts
- Eligible Yachts may enter by completing the attached “Entry Form” and sending it with the required fee by 5th February 2012 to: The Secretary TY&PBC, PO Box 93, Timaru
- Late Entries attract a “Late Entry Fee” of \$25
- All crew must be financial members of a Yacht Club affiliated to YNZ

3. CLASSIFICATION

- All yachts must comply with NZ Noelex 25 Association Prescriptions

4. ENTRY FEES

- The entry fee is \$110 if paid before 5th February 2012
- Late Entry Fee is \$135

5. VENUE

- TY&PBC is situated at Marine Parade, Caroline Bay, Timaru. See Attachment 1 for a map to venue.

6. SCHEDULE

- Registration:
 - Thursday 9th February 3pm – 6pm
 - Friday 10th February 8am – 11am
- Briefing:
 - Friday 10th February 11am
- Racing:
 - Friday 10th February Races 1, 2, 3, Warning Signal Race 1, 12.30 pm
 - Saturday 11th February Races 4, 5, 6, Warning Signal Race 4, 11.00 am
 - Sunday 12th February Races 7, 8, 9, Warning Signal Race 7, 11.00 am
 - Prize Giving to follow

7. MEASUREMENT CERTIFICATE

- Each boat must produce a current Weight Certificate

8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- Sailing Instructions will be available no later than the time of the briefing on Friday 10th February 2012

9. PENALTY SYSTEM

- Rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

10. SCORING

- 5 Races must be completed to constitute a series.
- When fewer than 6 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- When from 6 - 8 races are completed a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score
- When 9 races are completed a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her 2 worst scores.

11. SUPPORT BOATS

- All support boats will display the sail number of the boat they are supporting.

12. LAUNCHING

- Competitors must launch from TY&PBC ramps

13. COMMUNICATIONS WHILST RACING

- EXCEPT IN AN EMERGENCY - no boat shall receive or send any communications by radio or mobile phone

14. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- All competitors participate in the Regatta at their own risk, see Rule 44. "Decision to Race". The Organizing Authority will accept no responsibility for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during or following the Regatta.

15. INSURANCE

- Each participating boat must have a valid 3rd Party Insurance with a minimum cover of \$1,000,000 NZ dollars.

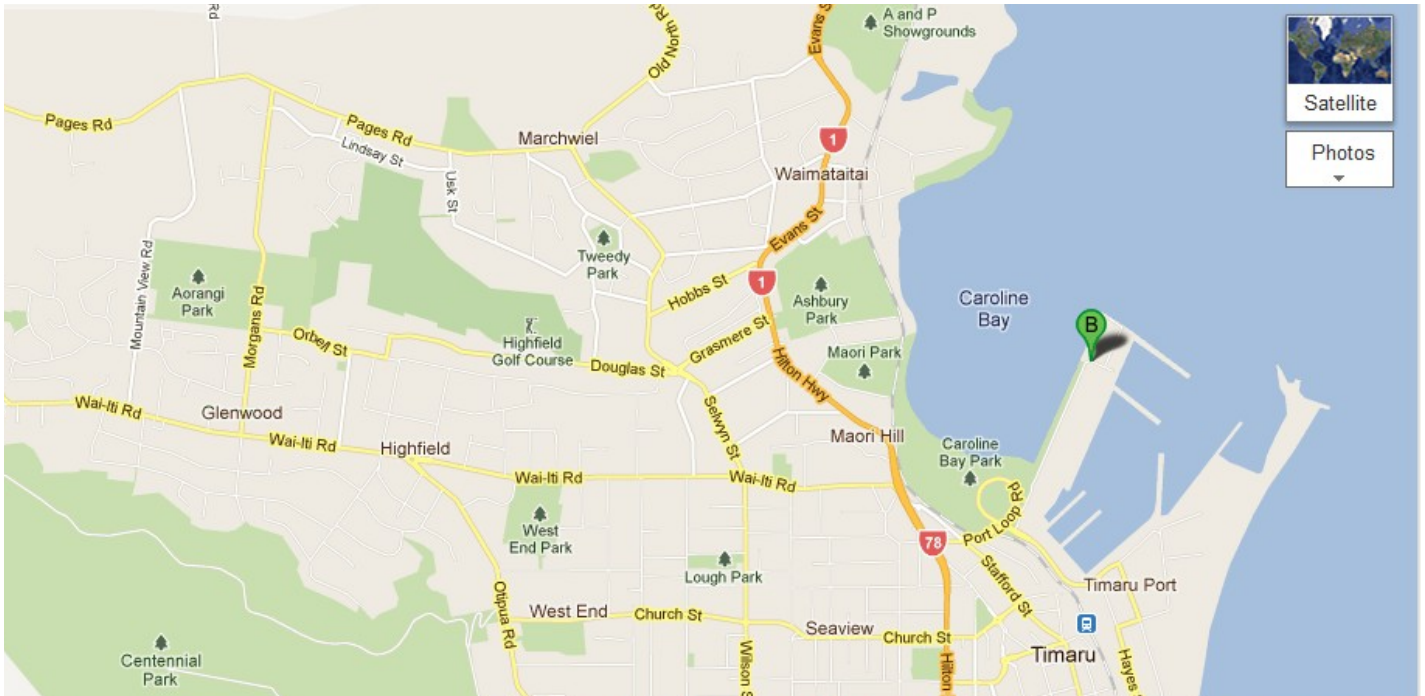
